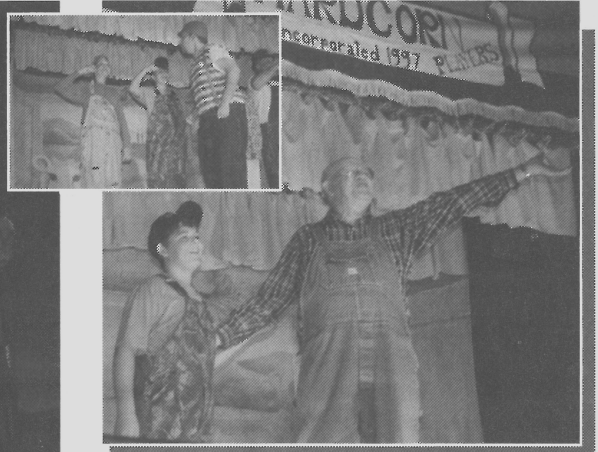


~ 1ST ANNUAL ~ PARSONS PEAVINE FESTIVAL!



The VanDell's delighted the crowd with some ole' time rock-n-roll Friday night during the Parsons Peavine Festival.



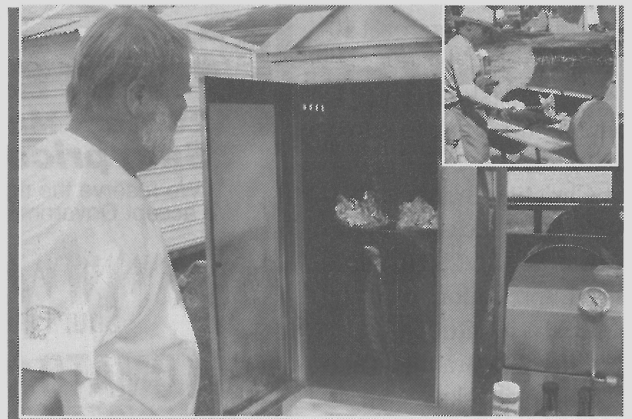
"Cotton" Ivy with protegee John Lawson Keeton kick started the Rivertime Players presentation of "How Now White Cow".

Comedian David Ferrel performed at St. Mark's AME Church to raise money for Habitat for Humanity.

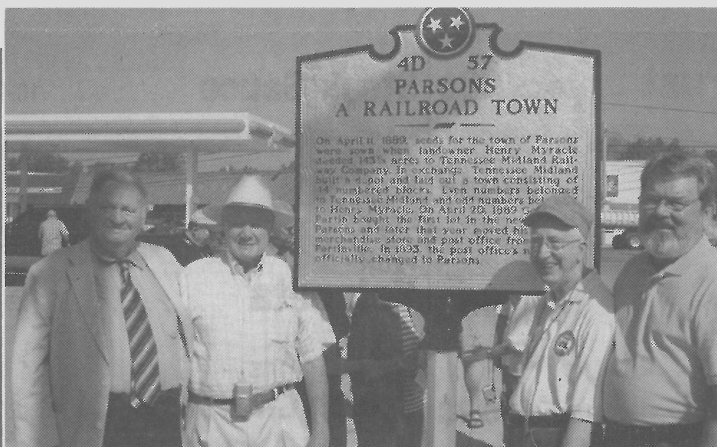
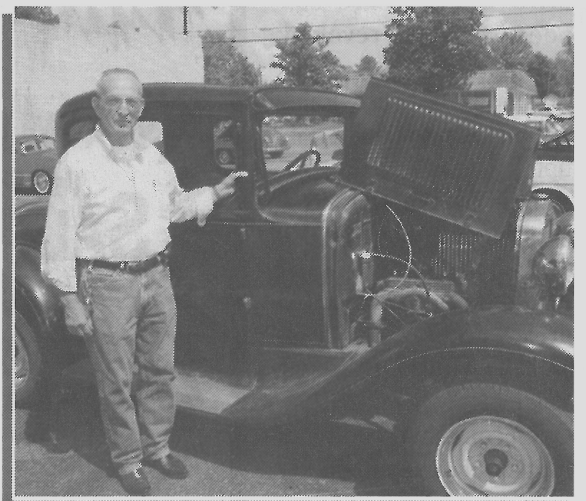


Marshall Burgess swept the BBQ cook-off, winning 1st place in every division.
