Toby Shows were part of an American folk-theatre art form of touring tent dramas. West Tennessee was Bisbee's Comedians' territory from 1927 until 1964, "Now only one Toby Show remains and it is here in Parsons," states Mark Tubbs, Executive Director. "Our goal is to present Toby Shows as authentically as possible to preserve this art form and to honor the original show companies.

Make plans now to enjoy an evening of Hysterical Historical Fun. Star Bores Episode LXXXVIII: A New Dope is scheduled to run six performances: Sept. 23rd, 24th and 30th, Oct. 1st. 7th and 8th. The tent opens at 6:30 p.m. and Star Bores will begin at 7:30 p.m. each night. The 45'X90' tent theater will be set up beside the Parsons Municipal Building at 535 Tennessee Avenue South. Admission is \$7.00 for adults and \$2.00 for children under 13.
